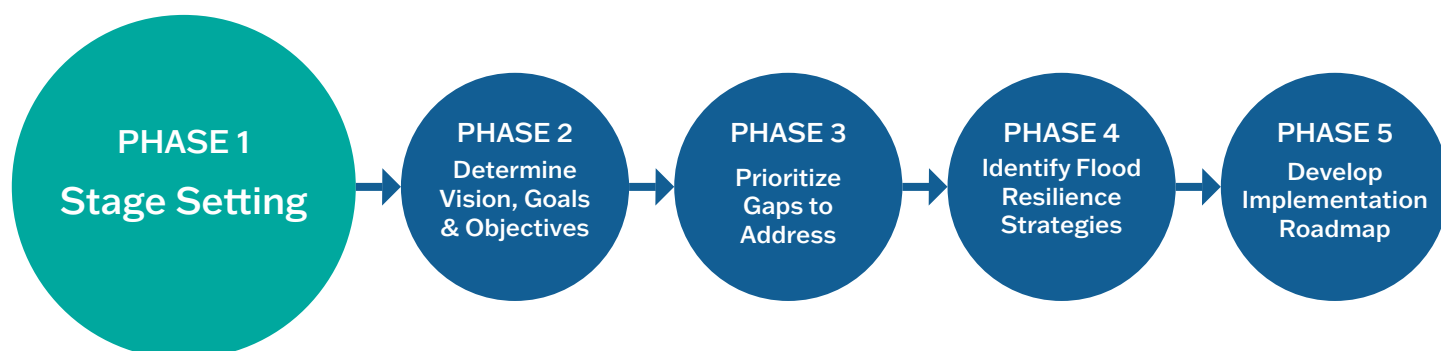
Virginia Flood Protection Master Plan
