
Virginia Flood Protection Master Plan

Purpose:

Define clear desired outcomes to guide the Virginia Flood Protection Master Plan.

Created a framework

to ensure the vision, goals, and objectives were aligned to ensure positive outcomes from the VFPMP.

Developed the VFPMP vision statement:

"A thriving Commonwealth proactively addressing flood risks to further strengthen the resilience of communities, the economy, and the environment now and into the future."

Identified three goals for achieving VFPMP's vision, with objectives to support each one:

Goal A: Mitigate current and future flood risks statewide

Goal B: Advance lasting and unified strategies to address flood risks

Goal C: Capture additional benefits through flood resilience
